NOTICE OF DOMESTIC SECTION 214 AUTHORIZATIONS GRANTED

WC Docket Nos. 17-353, 17-273 and 17-268

The Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) granted the applications listed in this notice pursuant to the Commission's streamlined procedures for domestic section 214 transfer of control applications, 47 CFR § 63.03.
