Re: Consolidated Application for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Inmate Calling Solutions, LLC to Securus Technologies, Inc. (WC Docket No. 18-193)

Dear Counsel:

By this letter, the Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) hereby informs you that we are restarting the Commission's informal 180-day shot clock associated with our review of the joint application seeking Commission approval to transfer control of Inmate Calling Solutions, LLC d/b/a ICSolutions (ICS) from TKC Holdings, Inc. (TKC) to Securus Technologies, Inc. (Securus) (together, Applicants).¹

By letter dated September 26, 2018, the Bureau advised you that it was pausing the Commission's informal 180-day clock for review of the above-referenced transaction as of September 25, 2018, the date by which Applicants' responses to the Commission's September 11, 2018 Information and Document Requests were due.² The letter indicated we would restart the informal clock when Applicants provided a full response to our requests, and the Commission staff had a reasonable time to review the documents to ensure as much. Applicants subsequently filed information, documents, and data in

response to our requests.³ We completed our review of that material and have determined that Applicants have now provided a complete response. Accordingly, we are restarting the informal 180-day clock, making today, February 1, 2019, Day 85 of the Commission's review.
