Re: Applications of T-Mobile U.S., Inc., and Sprint Corporation for Consent To Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations (WT Docket No. 18-197); Request for Data

Dear Mr. Johnson:

T-Mobile U.S., Inc., and Sprint Corporation have filed applications pursuant to Sections 214 and 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ seeking Commission consent to the transfer of control of licenses and authorizations from Sprint to T-Mobile. On July 18, 2018, the Commission accepted the applications for filing and established a pleading cycle for the proposed transaction.² For the Commission to complete its review of the applications under Sections 214 and 310(d) of the Act,³ we require data from Verizon. If necessary, we will follow up with additional requests for information and/or data.

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Act,⁴ we request that Verizon provide data as requested in the attached Data Request. We would appreciate receiving Verizon's response to the Data Request no later than October 1, 2018.

Your responses should be filed with Marlene H. Dortch, Secretary, Federal Communications Commission, in WT Docket No. 18-197. In addition, the *Comment Public Notice* and the *Protective Order*⁵ require the submission of multiple copies of all *ex parte* and other filings submitted in this proceeding. The Wireless Telecommunications Bureau also should receive, at a minimum, two copies of all paper filings. If you submit information pursuant to the *Protective Order* issued in this case, please



1. Provide data on the Company's offered capacity and traffic demand, as specified in Attachment A.
2. Provide data on the Company's costs, service plans, customers, wholesale customers, porting, and device sales, as specified in Attachment B.

The terms "Company" means Verizon Communications Inc., its domestic and foreign parents, predecessors, divisions, subsidiaries, affiliates, partnerships, and joint ventures, and all directors, officers, employees, agents, and representatives of the foregoing. The terms "parent," "subsidiary," "affiliate," and "joint venture" refer to any person in which there is partial (10 percent or more) or total ownership or control between the company and any other person.

Instructions

1. The specific requests made herein are continuing in nature. The Company is required to produce in the future any and all data and information that are responsive to the requests made herein but not initially produced at the time, date, and place specified herein. In this regard, the Company must supplement its responses (a) if the Company learns that, in some material respect, the data and information initially produced were incomplete or incorrect or (b) if additional responsive data or information are acquired by or become known to the Company after the initial production. The requirement to update the record will continue until the Commission's decision regarding the Transaction is no longer subject to reconsideration by the Commission or to review by any court.
2. Submit responses to this Data Request in electronic form. The Commission does not require the submission of paper copies of these data at this time, but reserves the right to require their submission at a later time.
3. Contact Commission staff to discuss an acceptable format for the submission of all data.
4. Data provided in response to this Data Request should include a list of all parameters/assumptions on which the data are based.
