(“AT&T”) respectfully seek the following modifications to the Proceeding Schedule issued in the August 7, 2019 Notice, as modified by the Letter Order dated August 12, 2019:

Due to work-related travel and other commitments, several AT&T attorneys responsible for this matter are unable to devote material time and attention to AT&T’s Reply this week. Also, AT&T’s outside counsel has an oral argument in Minnesota set for the current due date, October 9, 2019. Lastly, October 9, 2019 is a Jewish Holiday, and several responsible AT&T attorneys will not be available on that date.
