On behalf of the State of New Hampshire, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission hereby submits the State's application to renew its telecommunications relay service (TRS) certification for the five year period beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2023.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 64.604, Mandatory Minimum Standards, this application establishes that the State of New Hampshire's TRS program meets all operational, technical, and functional minimum standards, and also establishes, where those standards are exceeded, that the State's program in no way conflicts with federal law.
