**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES**  
**REGION 55 (NEW YORK - BUFFALO) 700 MHZ AND 800 MHZ REGIONAL PLANNING**  
**COMMITTEES TO HOLD MEETINGS**

The Region 55 (New York - Buffalo)<sup>1</sup> 700 MHz and 800 MHz Regional Planning Committees (RPCs) will hold a combined planning meeting on Thursday, October 18, 2018. Beginning at 10:00 a.m., the 700 MHz and 800 MHz RPCs will convene at the Genesee County Fire Training Facility, 7690 State Street Road, Batavia, New York 14020.

Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate, and represent their agency's needs.
