PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Congers NY DMS switch are associated with CLLI code CNGRNYCNDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Pleasantville NY DMS switch are associated with CLLI code PSVLNYPVPSA and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Congers DMS switch, located at 159 Lake Road, Congers, NY 10920, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Pleasantville DMS switch located at 465 Marble Ave, Pleasantville, NY 10570. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Pleasantville DMS switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Congers DMS switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Pleasantville DMS switch.

All ASRs for the Pleasantville DMS switch must be received no later than February 4, 2019 in order to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Congers DMS switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Congers DMS switch (**on or after April 19, 2019**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the two (2) native codes currently served by the Congers DMS switch to reflect the Pleasantville DMS switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Pleasantville DMS switch must carry the project code of **CNGRNYCNDS0**.
