RE: Confidentiality of NRUF / LNP Data

Dear Mr. Stockdale and Ms. Harris:

The Attorney General of the State of Florida (the "Attorney General") is investigating whether the proposed acquisition of Sprint Corporation by T-Mobile US, Inc. would violate any federal and/or Florida state laws. In connection with this investigation, the Attorney General issued a Civil Investigative Demand ("CID") pursuant to section 542.28, Florida Statutes, seeking access to documents and information that may contain Numbering Resource Utilization and Forecast ("NRUF") data and local number portability ("LNP") data.

It is the duty of the Attorney General to maintain the secrecy of all CID results except such results may be disclosed by the Attorney General to any court or tribunal in Florida or other law enforcement authorities of the Federal Government or other state governments that have confidentiality restrictions similar to section 542.28 (See Section 542.28(9), Florida Statutes). Additionally, if any documents or information we receive pursuant to CID should become the subject of a discovery request or public records request by a third party, the Attorney General shall assert all privileges, exemptions from, or other objections to disclosure in response to such request that the Attorney General in good faith deems appropriate under applicable law.
