PETITION FOR RULEMAKING

New Life Evangelistic Center, Inc. (NLEC) herewith moves the Commission to initiate a rulemaking proceeding to amend its Television Table of Allotments, 47 C.F.R., §73.606(b), to add Channel 58 at Kennett, Missouri.¹ The Table would read as follows:

¹ This replacement filing is for a previously filed Petition with the FCC through Mellon Bank on July 8, 1991, that apparently is missing. The original of the Engineering Report was attached to that submission.

NLEC is the licensee of Television Stations KNLC, Channel 24, St. Louis, Missouri and KNLJ, Channel 25, Jefferson City, Missouri, and, as such is in a position to activate said channel. In the event the Commission adds Channel 58 at Kennett to its Table of Allotments, NLEC will promptly file an application for a construction permit for a new station thereon and if granted will expeditiously construct.

Kennett, Missouri has a 1990 United States Census population of 10,941 and is located in Dunklin County, which has a 1990 United States Census population of 33,112. Kennett and Dunklin County are located in lower southeast Missouri near the Mississippi River. Neither Kennett nor any other community in Dunklin County is presently allotted a television channel.

Kennett, Missouri is the county seat of Dunklin County and serves a largely agricultural area. It boasts² a Chamber of Commerce, three banks and one saving and loan association, a full time police force of twenty officers, a seven member fire department with an additional twenty-nine volunteers, six motels, thirty-seven churches, four shopping centers, one public library, a one hundred sixteen bed hospital, three public elementary, three private elementary, one public junior and one public senior high schools. Its two largest employers


are Emerson Electric (with seven hundred employees) and Twin River Medical Center (with two hundred forty-eight employees).

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission's Television Table of Allotments should be amended to add Channel 58 to Kennett, Missouri.

ENGINEERING STATEMENT

The firm of E. Harold Munn, Jr. & Associates, Inc., was retained to prepare this Engineering Statement in support of a petition to add TV Channel 58, 734-740 MHz, for use at Kennett, Missouri.

Data contained in this report is responsive to the requirements of the Rules, as amended. It is proposed to amend 47 C.F.R. Section 73.606(b) to add Channel 58 for use serving the specified community.

Exhibit 1 is a pertinent portion of the computer study which demonstrates that, at the reference point listed, all the required separations are met. The reference point considered for the study is NL 36-03-55; WL 93-03-20. Kennett, Missouri is located in Zone II.

This reference point is a point proximate to the city from which the 10 mV/m(80 dBu) contour of the proposed station would encompass the entire community.
