Dear Mark:

Thank you for your letter of December 5, 1991 outlining your concerns regarding the proposed reallocation of the 2 GHz private microwave band to personal communications services' use.

The Salt River Project has been following this issue since its beginning and we share your concern regarding the availability of alternative reliable spectrum and the cost involved in migrating to it. However, due to our limited number of 2GHZ links, the age of our 2GHZ equipment, and our movement toward newer digital technology, the impact of the proposed changes on SRP is not expected to be as significant as it may be on many 2GHZ users.

Nevertheless, SRP will continue to stay abreast of this issue and support efforts to assure that the FCC provides for adequate compensation to anyone affected by the proposed changes. If there is any other information you might need, please feel free to call Don Spirk at (602) 236-2276.
