Please accept this correspondence as a request to petition the Federal Communications Commissions to allocate Channel 242 A (96.3 mhz) to Yankeetown, Florida a self incorporated town, under part 73.202 (B) of the Rules and Regulations.

Having conducted a computerized search of the FM Broadcast Band for Yankeetown, Florida, I have discovered that this frequency will comfortably fit, and will enable the public to be more greatly served by means of this new station.


