The SLD was contacted on June 21, 2016 with questions concerning reimbursement for FRN 2052890 for funding year 2010-2011. The amount paid for this FRN was \$2,967.55. I am told the funding commitment amount was reduced due to the customer Form 486 being filed past the deadline, and that after the 486 notification was received, an appeal could have been filed at that time. However, the company does not have records of this.

Since the deadline for filing an appeal is 60 days from the date of a notification letter, I was told to proceed with filing this appeal (which will be denied), after which time, an appeal with the FCC may be filed. Specifically, the company was not reimbursed for \$3,743.17 in credits issued and this appeal is to see if reimbursements may be issued.

This appeal is being filed timely (within 60 days of the date of the USAC denial letter dated September 8, 2016).
