Dear Ms. Dortch,

Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on October 3, 2019, Peter Pitsch, Executive Vice President, Advocacy & Government Relations, C-Band Alliance (“CBA”), met with Will Adams, advisor to Commissioner Carr.

During the meeting, Mr. Pitsch discussed the CBA’s proposal to clear, on a nationwide basis, a portion of the C-band for terrestrial 5G use via a market-based mechanism. Mr. Pitsch noted that a market-based mechanism would create strong incentives to clear spectrum efficiently and quickly, fostering 5G development in the United States. In addition, Mr. Pitsch touched upon the CBA’s customer commitment, including the CBA’s intent to install, repair, or replace equipment necessary to effectuate the transition of earth station operators to a smaller portion of the C-band.¹ Messrs. Pitsch and Adams also discussed timing and next steps in this proceeding.
