## NOTICE OF HEARING

The application of Dry Prong Educational Broadcasting Foundation for a construction permit to modify noncommercial station KVDP(FM) in Dry Prong, Louisiana to operate on Channel 207C2 and the application of Missionary Action Projects for a construction permit for a new noncommercial FM station on Channel 210A in Alexandria, Louisiana have been designated for hearing by the Federal Communications Commission.

The hearing is scheduled to begin on June 4, 1992 at the offices of the FCC in Washington, DC on the following issues:

1. To determine whether Missionary Action is qualified to be a noncommercial educational FM licensee.

2. If a final environmental impact statement is issued with respect to Dry Prong Educational and Missionary Action in which it is concluded that the proposed facilities are likely to have an adverse effect on the quality of the environment, to determine whether the proposals are consistent with the National Environmental Policy Act, as implemented by 47 C.F.R. Sections 1.1301-1319.

3. To determine: (a) the number of other reserved channel noncommercial educational FM services available in the proposed service area of each

applicant, and the area and population served thereby; (b) whether a share-time arrangement between the applicants would result in the most effective use of the channel and thus better serve the public interest and, if so, the terms and conditions thereof; and (c) in light of Section 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, which of the proposals would better provide a fair, efficient and equitable distribution of radio service.

4. To determine, in the event it is concluded that a choice between the applications should not be based solely on considerations relating to Section 307(b), the extent to which each of the proposed operations will be integrated into the overall cultural and educational objectives of the respective applicants; and whether other factors in the record demonstrate that one applicant will provide a superior FM educational broadcast service.

5. To determine, in light of the evidence adduced pursuant to the specified issues, which of the applications should be granted, if any.
