Re: Reaffirmation of Request for Expedited Treatment, *DIRECTV, LLC et al. v. Deerfield Media, Inc. et al.*, MB Docket No. 19-168, CSR-8979-C

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Defendants acknowledge that Complainants have recently requested that GoCom Media of Illinois, LLC (“GoCom”) be dismissed with prejudice from the above-captioned proceeding in light of the agreement reached between Complainants and GoCom concerning Complainants’ carriage of GoCom’s stations.¹ Notwithstanding the settlement by one of the nine Defendants, as we stated in our letter of August 28, 2019,² Complainants’ position makes restoration of carriage exceedingly difficult prior to a resolution of the merits by the Commission. As such, expedited treatment and the certainty that a decision will provide are important not only for the parties to this proceeding, but also for future potential disputes of a similar nature in the industry. Accordingly, Defendants respectfully reaffirm the pending unopposed request for expedited treatment submitted by Complainants.
