**Re: Ex Parte Presentation, Process for Relicensing 700 MHz Spectrum in Unserved Areas, WT Docket No. 06-150.**

Dear Ms. Dortch,

On October 6, 2017, Kara Romagnino Graves of CTIA and Tom Dombrowsky of DLA Piper (for CTIA) spoke by phone with Roger Noel and Anna Gentry of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau ("Bureau") to discuss the above-captioned proceeding.

During the call, and consistent with CTIA's comments in this proceeding,<sup>1</sup> CTIA reiterated that the Bureau should ensure that 700 MHz licensees have the flexibility needed to accurately determine coverage provided by their networks, in particular by permitting licensees to make showings of coverage based on actual coverage. CTIA also discussed its requests that the Bureau streamline the application process for relicensing 700 MHz spectrum.
