On September 12, 2019, the National Association for State Relay Administration (NASRA) held its annual conference in Phoenix, Arizona. One of the conference panels focused on the proposed use of Automatic Speech Recognition (ASR) as an alternative method of providing Internet Protocol Captioned Telephone Services (IP CTS).
