Dear Secretary Dortch:

On December 28, 2017, Global Tel*Link Corporation (“GTL”) representatives Todd Stutts, Senior Vice President of Sales, and John Pilcher, Manager Sales Engineer, and representatives of the South Carolina Department of Corrections (“SCDC”), Brian Sterling, Director, Mike McCall, Deputy Director Operations, and Lee Derickson, Legislative Liaison met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn at the SCDC facility in Columbia, South Carolina on matters pertinent to the above-referenced Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) proceedings.

The purpose of the meeting was to demonstrate GTL’s tablet communication technology and explain how GTL is partnering with the SCDC and other facilities to bring the many benefits of new technologies to enable greater communication with family and friends, and to provide a variety of content useful to inmates while incarcerated and after release, including educational, video communications, telemedicine, and other content.

GTL also reviewed the educational information accessible through the tablet, as well as other applications, and future content. GTL representatives also discussed the development of the tablet, and the ongoing efforts to improve and enhance the tablet technology and expand content.

GTL also played its preloaded informational video and explained the company's plans to have multiple videos covering a variety of topics available to inmates via the tablet. GTL representatives closed the meeting with a live operator video relay service ("VRS") demonstration, explaining how GTL has deployed VRS at all SCDC locations.
