Re: Notice of Ex Parte Communication, ET Docket No. 18-295; GN Docket No. 17-183

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 5, 2018, Robert Weller and the undersigned, both of the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) met with staff copied below in the Office of Engineering and Technology. During this meeting, we discussed the attached presentation regarding the Commission's draft Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding unlicensed use of the 6 GHz band.¹

NAB explained that broadcasters make extensive use of the U-NII-6 and U-NII-8 bands identified in the Draft NPRM. These bands are used for electronic news gathering including, for example, the use of portable transmitters on cameras to relay audio and video as well as temporary fixed links to transmit program material back to studios. NAB appreciates the efforts of the Commission staff to address potential interference issues by proposing to confine unlicensed operations in the U-NII-6 and U-NII-8 bands to indoor operations. However, the specific broadcast uses of these bands raise two significant challenges.

First, confining unlicensed operations in these bands to indoor operations does not address the potential for interference to broadcast operations that may take place indoors – such as at sports venues, political conventions or other events. Second, broadcast use for newsgathering operations tends to have high “RF visibility” because these links travel over long distances. Such links can easily travel through residential areas where unlicensed operations near windows could cause interference.

NAB will address these issues in detail in its comments in this proceeding. We suggest, however, that the Commission would be more likely to gather a full record in this proceeding, including suggestions as to how these issues might be resolved, if the final NPRM directly

asks whether unlicensed operations in the U-NII-6 and U-NII-8 bands should be confined to residential areas and how to effectively restrict those operations to residential areas.
