ACS of Fairbanks, LLC d/b/a Alaska Communications proposes to incorporate the retired 4682 Dale Road copper into the existing fiber fed Digital Loop Carrier (DLC) equipment at 3715 University Avenue. This DLC is required to eliminate the existing buried cable physical feed currently conflict with University Avenue construction project. Existing underground and buried cables will be used for distribution from the DLC allowing minimal impact to the surrounding area. The incorporated DLC will also provide essential non-loaded POTS, DSL, and HDSL services to a portion of southwest Fairbanks.
