Colorado Valley Communications, Inc., Nortex Communications Company and Pathway Com-Tel, Inc. (together, the “Texas Carriers”) submitted comments¹ to the above captioned Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on December 28, 2017. In their comments, the Texas Carriers urged the Federal Communications Commission to retain census tract-sized licenses for Priority Access Licenses (PALs), increase the term of the PALs to ten years with an expectation of renewal and address Spectrum Access System administrators’ fees.
