
AMENDMENT

The application of Peaches Broadcasting, Ltd. is hereby amended to update Exhibit 1 (Media Interests) to its application. This amendment reports the voluntary dismissal of the application of Rupert of East Baton Rouge Broadcasting L.P. ("Rupert") for a new FM construction permit in Baker, Louisiana. It also reports the issuance of two orders adding issues against Rupert. Peaches' limited partner, United Communications, Inc. ("UCI") was a limited partner of Rupert.

The underlying allegations related either to reporting requirements, to the financial abilities of Rupert's former limited partners and a felony conviction of one of Rupert's former limited partners. None of these matters involved UCI or anyone connected with UCI.

SUPPLEMENT TO EXHIBIT 1 (MEDIA INTERESTS)

The media interests of United Communications, Inc. and its principals, previously reported in Exhibit 1 and periodically revised pursuant to 47 CFR §1.65, are hereby amended as follows.

1. On April 15, 1991, Judge Miller added the following issues against Rupert of East Baton Rouge Broadcasting L.P. ("Rupert"):

Rupert-1 To determine if Rupert misrepresented or lacked candor when they certified in their application that they were financially qualified, and if so, whether Rupert is basically qualified to be a Commission licensee;


Rupert-2 To determine if Rupert has been continuously qualified financially from December 15, 1988 to the present, and if not, what impact that has on Rupert's qualifications to be a Commission licensee;

Rupert-3 To determine if Rupert violated 47 CFR 1.65 by failing to amend BPH-881251NQ to report the specific adverse findings made against their two limited partners (Hubert Payne and Darrell Fields) in the Columbus, Ohio Channel 298A proceeding; and if so, what impact that has on Rupert's qualifications to be a Commission licensee; and

Rupert-4 To determine if Rupert violated 47 CFR 1.65 by failing to amend BPH-881251NQ to report the specific adverse findings made against their two limited partners (Hubert Payne and Darrell Fields) in the Roswell, Georgia Channel 298A proceeding; and if so, what impact that has on Rupert's qualifications to be a Commission licensee.


2. On April 15, 1991, Judge Walter C. Miller added the following issues against Rupert by Order, FCC 91M-1306:

Rupert-5 To determine if Rupert violated 47 CFR 1.65 by failing to timely report the arrest and indictment of their limited partner, Hubert Payne, for 18 USC 317 and 18 USC 1956 violations, and if so, what impact that has on Rupert's qualifications to be a Commission licensee;



Rupert-6 To determine whether Rupert has misrepresented to or lacked candor with the Commission by failing to timely amend Section II, Question 10(b) of FCC Form 301.

3. On April 23, 1991, Rupert moved to voluntarily dismiss its application. That motion was granted by Order, FCC 91M-1453 (released April 25, 1991).

MEDIA INTERESTS

Frederick Matthews formerly owned considerably less than 0.001% (less than 50 shares) of the stock of the Boston Globe pursuant to a stock option plan he exercised while employed at WOKV-AM, Jacksonville, Florida. The Boston Globe no longer owns that station. Mr. Matthews sold his stock over three years ago.

Since May, 1990, Mr. Matthews has been employed as General Manager of WSVE(AM), which is owned by Darrell Spann. Mr. Matthews holds no ownership interest in WSVE(AM). As reported in Peaches' application, Mr. Matthews will resign all outside employment if Peaches' application is granted.

On December 26, 1990, the 75% ownership interest in Peaches formerly held by Stephan Weissman was assigned to United Communications, Inc. ("UCI"). UCI is a District of Columbia Corporation whose address of record is 1425 Fourth St. S.W. #A-105, Washington, D.C. 20024. UCI has one class of shares (common and voting) and 84 shares outstanding. Family relationships among stockholders of UCI are as follows:

- a. C.C. Haydel is Glenn Haydel's minor son.

- b. Gilbert A. Maddox is Burke Syphax' brother-in-law and Gregory Syphax' father-in-law. Gregory Syphax is Burke Syphax' adult son.

The media interests of UCI and its principals are all nonattributable. UCI currently holds, or formerly has held, the following investments in FM construction permit applications. In each instance, UCI was or is an insulated limited partner pursuant to a written limited partnership agreement meeting the Commission's requirements as set out in Attribution Rules (Reconsideration), 58 RR2d 615 (1985).

1. UCI held a 49% equity interest in Hairston Broadcasting Limited Partnership ("Hairston"), an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Mableton, Georgia, MM Docket No. 88-400, File No. BPH-870710NO. Hairston has ceased to exist. Its application was denied in Mableton Broadcasting Company, Inc., 5 FCC Rcd 2474 (ALJ, released April 11, 1990), and Hairston did not appeal. The I.D. found Hairston not to be financially qualified, but the decision did not find UCI or any UCI principal to be at fault in connection with Hairston's financial disqualification.

 2. Rocky Mount Broadcasting Limited Partnership ("Rocky Mount") was an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Rocky Mount, North Carolina, MM Docket No. 88-299, File No. BPH-870430MH. Rocky Mount's application was designated for hearing by HDO, 3 FCC Rcd 4022 (released June 28, 1988). Rocky Mount's application was dismissed pursuant to a settlement. MO&O, FCC 89M-1235 (released April 21, 1989). UCI held a 49% equity interest in Rocky Mount.

3. Sunsett Broadcasting Company L.P. ("Sunsett") was an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Belle Chasse, Louisiana, MM Docket No. 88-206, File No. BPH-870527MA. Sunsett's application was designated for hearing by HDO, 3 FCC Rcd 2680 (released May 9, 1988). Sunsett's application was dismissed pursuant to a universal settlement of the case by MO&O, FCC 89M-1823 (released July 10, 1989). UCI held a 70% equity interest in Sunsett.
4. UCI held a 20% equity interest in Sylvester Communications Limited Partnership ("Sylvester"), an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Sylvester, Georgia, File No. BPH-880505ND. Sylvester did not respond to the HDO, 5 FCC Rcd 3054 (released May 16, 1990) in the Sylvester proceeding, and the partnership no longer exists.
5. UCI held a 70% equity interest in Metro Tallahassee Broadcasters ("Metro Tallahassee"), an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Tallahassee, Florida, MM Docket No. 90-431, File No. BPH-8803240A. Metro Tallahassee did not respond to the HDO, DA 90-1249 (released December 3, 1990) in the Tallahassee FM proceeding, and the partnership no longer exists.
6. UCI holds a 20% equity interest in Southeast Communications Limited Partnership ("Southeast"), an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Macon, Georgia, MM Docket No. 90-279, File No. BPH-880421MO. Southeast's application was designated for hearing by HDO, 5 FCC Rcd 3504 (released June 12, 1990). Southeast proposes to dismiss its application pursuant to a universal settlement of the case.
7. UCI holds a 75% equity interest in Jamal Broadcasting, L.P., an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Mt. Juliet, Tennessee, File No. BPH-891012MS. Jamal's application has not yet been designated for hearing.
8. UCI holds a 75% equity interest in Rupert of East Baton Rouge Broadcasting L.P. ("Rupert"), an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Baker, Louisiana, File No. BPH-881215NQ. Rupert's application has not yet been designated for hearing.



In addition, Dr. James Freemont, a 16.67% stockholder in UCI, is a 50% equity holder and sole limited partner in TFB Associates Limited Partnership ("TFB"), an applicant for an FM construction permit to serve Hogansville, Georgia, MM Docket No. 90-52, File No. BPH-880602NB. TFB is an insulated limited partner pursuant to a written limited partnership agreement meeting the Commission's requirements as set out in Attribution Rules (Reconsideration), 58 RR2d 615 (1985). TFB's application was designated for hearing by HDO, 5 FCC Rcd 948 (released February 21, 1990). After designation for hearing, site availability and site certification issues were designated against TFB; however, the issues did not involve Dr. Freemont in any way. TFB and the other two applicants in the proceeding have proposed to merge; TFB would own 33% of the merged entity, giving Dr. Freemont, indirectly, a 16.5% equity interest in the merged entity. The merger is presently before Judge Kuhlmann for review.



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MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: April 12, 1991 ; Released: April 16, 1991

1. Under consideration are 1) Motion for Summary Decision, filed March 21, 1991 by Charley Cecil & Dianna Mae White, d/b/a White Broadcasting Partnership; 2) Mass Media Bureau's Comments in Support of Motion for Summary Decision, filed April 4, 1991. White seeks summary decision on an air hazard issue specified against it. White shows that the Federal Aviation Administration has determined that White's proposed antenna would not pose a structural hazard, but that his proposal has the potential of causing electromagnetic interference ("EMI"). White agrees to the imposition of the following condition upon its construction permit:

Upon receipt of notification from the Federal Communications Commission that harmful interference is being caused by the operation of the licensee's (permittee's) transmitter, the licensee (permittee) shall either immediately reduce the power to the point of no interference, cease operation, or take such immediate corrective action as necessary to eliminate the harmful interference. This condition expires after one year of interference-free operation.

There is no indication that the Federal Aviation Administration objects to the imposition of the condition. The motion for summary decision will be granted.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Motion IS GRANTED and the air hazard issue specified against White is resolved, CONDITIONED as set forth above, in his favor.
