
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 10, 2019, Tim Totten, Wireless Architect, United Parcel Service, Inc. ("UPS") and Lance Johnson, Vice President, Spectrum Strategy & Government Affairs, Anterix, Inc. met with the Office of Engineering & Technology personnel listed below. Mr. Totten described the pending UPS experimental application to test UPS-specific use cases using 900 MHz LTE devices at its Billings facility in the proposed 900 MHz broadband segment. He also discussed the possibility of testing 3.5 GHz CBRS and 900 MHz spectrum in the same device in the future. Mr. Johnson explained that there are no 900 MHz incumbents in the geographic area of UPS's proposed trial. Mr. Totten asked that the experimental application be processed as soon as possible.
