Requests for Pioneer's Preference Filed

The Chief Engineer today accepted for comment five requests for pioneer's preference that address proposals for initiating new communications services using satellites operating above 1 GHz. These requests were filed by: 1) Constellation Communications, Inc. (Constellation) on February 20, 1992; 2) Ellipsat Corporation (Ellipsat) on July 29, 1991; 3) Loral Qualcomm Satellite Services, Inc. (Loral) on November 4, 1991; 4) Motorola Satellite Communications, Inc. (Motorola) on July 30, 1991; and 5) TRW Inc. (TRW) on September 6, 1991. These requests for pioneer's preference are consolidated into ET Docket No. 92-28.

The requests have been assigned the following file numbers: Constellation -- PP-29; Ellipsat -- PP-30; Loral -- PP-31; Motorola -- PP-32; and TRW -- PP-33. Parties desiring to comment on these requests must reference both the file number and Docket on the cover page of their comments. Comments must be submitted by April 8, 1992. Reply comments must be submitted by April 23, 1992.
