**Re: Update to Parts 2 and 25 Concerning Non-Geostationary, Fixed-Satellite Service
Systems and Related Matters, *IB Docket 16-408***

Dear Ms. Dortch,

EchoStar Satellite Operating Corporation and Hughes Network Systems, LLC, Iridium Constellation LLC, and Telesat Canada (collectively, the “Petitioners”) filed a joint petition for reconsideration on January 17, 2018 of a single element of the *Report and Order* in the above captioned proceeding, relating to the addition of footnote NG62 to the Table of Frequency Allocations. The Petitioners would like to correct the description of the speeds that will be delivered by the next generation EchoStar XXIV/Jupiter 3 high-throughput satellite contained in footnote 1. The sentence states that EchoStar XXIV/Jupiter 3 will deliver speeds of around “100 Mbps up and 10 Mbps down.” The Petitioners hereby correct the sentence to state that EchoStar XXIV/Jupiter 3 will deliver speeds of around “100 Mbps *down* and 10 Mbps *up*” [emphasis added for clarity].
