INTEGRATION STATEMENT

Charley White

Charley White, 50% General Partner of White Broadcasting Partnership, will work at the station as the General Manager and Sales Manager. He will be employed as the General Manager and Sales Manager for a minimum of 40 hours per week, on a day-to-day basis. As the General Manager, he will be responsible for hiring, training, and supervision of all station staff, and will be ultimately responsible for all administrative and budgetary matters, and for technical operations of the station. As the Sales Manager, Mr. White will be responsible for all advertising sales and contracts, and for management of all stations sales staff.

Mr. White is presently employed as Station Manager of WJXR-FM, and will resign that position within two weeks of a grant of a Construction Permit for the proposed Station in Baldwin, Florida.

Minority Preference

Mr. White will claim a comparative preference as a member of a minority group. Mr. White is part Native American Indian.

Local Residence

Mr. White has resided within the 3.16 mV/m signal contour of the proposed station since 1981, (with a single four-month absence during this period), and will claim a comparative credit for his service area residency.

be responsible for supervision of all day-to-day station operations
and all station staff, including all remote broadcast operations,
and will supervise traffic and bookkeeping. As the Program
Director, she will be responsible for the station's format,
including formulation of the station's overall format, and for
formulation and implementation of the day-to-day programming for
the station, including station advertising, news, public interest
programming, and music programming.

Mrs. White is presently employed as Manager of Permits and
Licensing for Ranger Transportation, a national trucking company.
In that position, she is responsible for arranging permits and

licenses required for all vehicles from the ICC, DOT, EPA, and state licensing agencies through the United States, and government agencies in Canada. If White Broadcasting Partnership is granted a construction permit for a new FM Station at Baldwin, she will resign that position approximately two weeks prior to the start of program testing for the new facility.



GUIDELINES TO THE MODEL EEO PROGRAM
