Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 10, 2017, David Aldworth, Gary Fry and the undersigned, representing Teliax, Inc. (Teliax) met with Amy Bender from Commissioner O’Rielly’s office. We discussed Teliax’ positions previously filed in the above-captioned proceedings.

Teliax explained how the existing rules for originating and toll free access enables quality service, competition, economic growth, employment and innovation, including Teliax’s Toll Free Exchange. The Toll Free exchange enables routing of toll free calls on a RespOrg to RespOrg basis, using SOMOS 8YY data, over IP transport and on the basis of contract, rather than under tariffs. We also discussed how AT&T’s proposal to make end user customers pay for toll free calls could result in the demise of toll free calling and is inconsistent with the public interest.
