

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
RESPOND TO PETITION TO DISMISS OR DENY**

Bible Broadcasting Network, Inc. ("BBN"), applicant for a construction permit for a new FM station at Conway, Florida, hereby respectfully requests an extension of time up to and including August 22, 1990, within which to respond to the "Petition to Dismiss or Deny" filed by Florida Public Radio, Inc. ("FPR"). In support whereof, the following is shown:

The "Petition to Dismiss or Deny" was filed by FPR on July 25, 1990. It was received in Washington counsel's office somewhat later because FPR mailed the pleading to counsel's client in Chesapeake, Virginia. The normal date for response to the Petition would be August 8, 1990. The Petition makes serious allegations with respect to the BBN application. Substantial research has been necessary in order to properly respond to the Petition. A proper response also requires coordination with BBN's consulting engineer, and the Director of Engineering for WCPX-TV, Orlando, Florida. Counsel's absence from the office, and his involvement in litigation has drastically limited the


amount of time he has had to concentrate on the preparation of a proper response. Further, counsel has learned that other parties have requested extensions of time within which to respond to the Petition. For example, counsel for Hispanic Radio System, Inc., requested an extension through August 22, 1990. For consistency in the pleading cycle, therefore, BBN requests a like extension to respond up to August 22, 1990. BBN's counsel has attempted to contact Randy Henry, the President of FPR in order to obtain consent to this Motion for Extension of Time but has been unsuccessful in speaking with Mr. Henry.

No party will be prejudiced by an extension of time which will result in BBN's being able to present the Commission with a well researched and complete response to the Petition to Dismiss or Deny.

WHEREFORE, in light of the foregoing, BBN respectfully requests that the time for responding to the Petition to Dismiss or Deny filed July 25, 1990, by FPR be extended through August 22, 1990.

PETITION TO DISMISS OR DENY

Florida Public Radio, Inc. (FPR), pursuant to Section 309(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 73.3584 of the Commission's Rules, hereby petitions to dismiss or deny the instant applications of the proposals captioned above (herinafter called "Applicants").

1. By public notice, the Commission has explicitly invited the filing of Petitions to Deny the instant "Applications," and FPR is filing this Petition within the time allotted therefor. The "Applications" are listed in cut-off list B-118.

2. Section 73.525 of the Commission's Rules makes specific requirements of applicants where a proposal causes there to be an affected TV six facility. The captioned "Applications" are proposing facilities that are not collocated with the affected TV six (they are in excess of .4 kilometers removed). The Commission clearly requires that in the absence of collocation, a showing must be made that the interference contour contains no more than 3000 persons.

3. The captioned "Applications" have ignored the Commission's allocation requirements. Their proposals desire that the Commission waive its rules which, for good reasons, set limits on how many persons may be interfered with, and as an excuse to have the Commission grant this favored treatment, they have produced a letter written by an employee of the affected TV six.

4. Examining the content of the letter(s) that the "Applications" have received from the TV six employee, reveals that: FIRST MEDIA CORP (licensee of TV six) HAS NOT STATED THAT IT IS GRANTING TO THE APPLICANTS AN UNCONDITIONAL WAIVER OF THE PROTECTION IT IS DUE IN SECTION 73.525.

5. Moreover, the captioned "Applications" in exchange for their noncomplying submissions, should have at the least, submitted along with their noncomplying proposals, an irrevocable consent agreement from the ownership of TV six (and not an employee unless a document can be shown which allocates that authority to that employee). The letter submitted with the noncomplying proposal(s) of the captioned "Applications" is a wishy-washy, pen-pal comment that says I see no problem if you this and if you that.

6. In the light that two of the six mutually exclusive applicants have managed to find locations for their facilities which are in compliance with the Commission's rules regarding interference to TV six, FPR asks the Commission to Dismiss or Deny the noncomplying applications.

7. In the event the Commission choses not to dismiss or deny, FPR requests that the Commission require of the "Applicants:"


- a. an interference study to demonstrate the number of residents predicted to receive interference from their facilities.
- b. a corporate resolution from the ownership of First Media Corporation that grants irrevokable consent making Section 73.525 of no issue in the construction and operation of the proposal(s) of the "Applicants."

Wherefore, the petition considered, the captioned applications should be denied or dismissed, and if not, a required filing of "a" and/or "b" above.


