

**“University St. Augustine’s & Institutes of Medicine”
High Quality
Higher Education Act 2019**

(“USA’s HQ - HIGHER EDUCATION ACT 2019”)

1. Restoration, Licenses to operate the University St. Augustine’s (Meharry Allied Health Learning Center, Inc. (Meharry College, LLC) consistent with [Federal District Court Orders](#); 1.9.1985, 6.1986, 11.27.1995, 6.1987 and August 1987;

- i. Sanction of the Governor’s Task Force to *facilitate the sunset of institutional accreditation eligibility specifications, and perpetuate restoration of the Institutional Accreditation* of the Institution of Higher Education formerly known as Meharry Allied Health Learning Center, Inc.(“MAHLC”).

A proprietary Institution of Higher Education with Junior College authority, granted full Institutional Accreditation by A.B.H.E.S, a U.S.D.E recognized National Accreditation Agency.

Operational as the fiduciary of Shaw College At Detroit, a Historic Black College and University, with authority unlimited to operate multiple Pre-K - 12 university preparatory schools, functioning in the capacity known as Meharry College, LLC, pursuant to the authority of U.S. Presidential Executive Order 12320; September 15, 1981, and U.S. Department Agriculture Implementation Plan; January 15, 1985, entitled access to federal funds pursuant to HEA 1965, Amended, eligibility status preserved; [Legal Opinion; 10.18.2018.](#)

The Governor’s Task Force shall facilitate restoration of MAHLC actualized as the “University St. Augustine’s” (“USA”), an Institution of Higher Education that has full Institutional Accreditation by a National Accreditation Agency, recognized by U.S. Department of Education.

- ii. Perpetuate resumption of obligations pledged by former Governor John Engler to facilitate actualization of the MSU Extension; Research & Development in partnership alliance with “University St. Augustine’s and Institutes of Medicine” to establish the “Independent Institutes for College Preparation” (“ICP”) within annexes comprising the University College Centers as a means to prepare minds academically, and perpetuate the *elimination of Education as the Civil Rights Crisis of the 21st Century*. A concept “USA” introduced and former President George W. Bush endorsed.
 - iii. Restoration Accredited Institute of Higher Education Library that supports “USA’s” College of Law, School of Liberal Arts, and College of Nursing and Allied Health Sciences.
 - iv. Restoration innovative technology infrastructure and capital equipment extending access to FCC E-Rate Grant to facilitate PBN that features Competency-Based-Education Curriculum in alliance with eligible Title IV institutions.
2. Designation, University St. Augustine’s as a Land Grant College, pursuant to 1890 Morrill Act, Amended, consistent with the Extension Land Grant College Initiative 1994, as sanctioned by former Governor James Blanchard.
3. Fund the University St. Augustine’s Endowment Trust with One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) as committed by former Governor James Blanchard.
4. Convey Deed of Interest to [Annex of Cadillac Place](#); Rear annex addition from Cass and Milwaukee Street, Detroit as an alternative to the state owned property formerly known as Clinton Valley Hospital comprising 7-commercial buildings and more than 100 acres that former Governor John Engler donated and authorized for use as the Regional Detroit Campus of the “University St. Augustine’s”.

5. Empower the offices of the State Attorney General to Direct the Michigan Department of Education facilitate *restoration of "Caroline Education Community International Public School Academy" (PSA) to good standing in the MEG's Plus System*. As the MDE arbitrarily purged CECI PSA from the system upon upgrade of the MEG's System. Thereby, compromising CECI PSA's eligibility as a FCC E-Rate and ESSA Grant recipient that provides K-12 academic educational services within 16 - minority communities throughout the State of Michigan.
6. Issue an Executive Declaration that authorizes the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to distribute forthwith, the E-Rate Grant approved and held in abeyance on behalf of Caroline Education Community International Public School Academy, retroactive to 2014.

Federal Grant Awarded Caroline Education Community International Public School Academy totals in excess of Eleven Million Dollars (\$11,000,000). Funding the Michigan Department of Education intentionally torted by purging CECI PSA registration in the MEG's Plus System on purpose and with wilful intent, endeavoring to substantiate allegations of non-existence, deceitfully prepetrating CECI PSA's extinction. As MDE consistently misadvises the FCC's fiduciary, "USAC" that CECI PSA is not a school *"as it is not listed in the MEG's Plus System MDE prescribes"* and caused to be created effective May 2015.

Thereby, deliberately infringing upon the legal civil rights of CECI PSA as an eligible K-12 education corporation. Impeding the capacity of CECI PSA to function and practice on a equal basis as its cohorts, and provide state of the art cutting edge academic educational innovations and progression as an educational institution. 7. Direct Michigan Treasury to disburse funds authorized pursuant to Executive Order former Governor Jennifer Granholm issued November 5, 2003, that mandates the organization, implementation and perpetual operations of Caroline Education Community International Public School Academy as functional Pre-K- 12 University Preparatory Academy. The amount of funds to be determined based on a Accounting provided by a qualified Certified Public Accountant.
8. Direct the Michigan Department of Education to honor the "Certificate of Occupancy" issued initially 2004-2006, and subsequently, September 2017 and November 2017, by the Michigan Fire Safety to Caroline Education Community International Public School Academy September 2016, for *temporary use* of the educational portal located at 22579 Ann Arbor Trail, Dearborn Heights, MI 48127 to continue operations of the Pre-K to 12Th Grade Preparatory School Academy established consistent with MCL 450.171.
9. Establishment of a Scholarship Repository in interest of citizens that are eligible, enrolled, attending, and successfully progress at the University to ensure its perpetual preservation, and endorsement of a Capital Fund in payment of attendance in upper level college; junior and senior year. Reassign academic programs distributed to other colleges universities, and non-profit organizations initially created, implemented and administered by Meharry Allied Health Learning Center, Inc. (Meharry College, LLC).
10. Sanction the establishment of a "Legacy Referendum" that advocates implementation of "St. Augustine's Institutes for College Preparation ("ICP")" within annexes comprising the University College Centers ("UCC's").

Wherein, instructional program courses designed to prepare the minds of students academically to help retain and move the students rapidly into core courses and through program completion, which may include remedial education, English language instruction or English as a Second Language, shall be administratively managed and funded.

The campus annexes shall manifest academically as Virtual "University College Centers" featuring Institutes of St. Augustine's Technical Education Excellences, hosted by St. Augustine's Live - Private Broadcast Network (L-PBN) in alliance with renowned accredited Institutions of Higher Education.

As such, the University College Centers shall become empowered consistent with leveraged federal resources comprising the HUD EnVision Demonstration Initiatives, the U.S. DOL Pre-Apprenticeships and Apprenticeships, DOJ, U.S.DE, U.S.V.A, U.S.D.C, FCC and the H.U.D; HBCU. As well, state resources, including MSHDA, DHS, MHD, ESSA, FCC, and HEA 1965, Amended.

11. Sanction the creation of 21st Century Community Learning Centers (“21st CCLC”) that serve a high percentage of students from low-income families, and provide students with academic enrichment opportunities, as well as additional services designed to complement their regular academic program.

Community Learning Centers shall offer families of participating students literacy instruction and related educational development programs.

Proposed activities shall target students and families of students residing in minority communities, wherein MDE, and the former Administration perpetrated the catastrophic Dissolution of Public School System within minority communities throughout the state of Michigan.

Sanction eligibility of CECI PSA to enable its active participation and access to Title I | ESSA | FCC funding for purposes of program administration of the 21st CCLC’s.

Endorse the re-employment within the USA UCC System, 65% of the qualified faculty and administrative staff impacted as a result of displacement due to the Dissolution of Public School Systems within 14-of-18 Minority Communities throughout the state of Michigan.

12. Authorize the State Attorney General to Share the Governor’s endeavors to ensure Anti-Bias in compliance with provisions of Title VI within the Civil Rights Act 1964, with the Mayor, City of Detroit, and Wayne County Executive, and U.S. Department of Education to benefit the Capital Fund for the USA Endowment Trust and Academic Scholarship Fund.

In association with Tax Credits and funding authorized, galvanize the steel and aluminum corporate renaissance stakeholders for projects along the Detroit Riverfront, including Ford Motor Historic Train Station, Matty Moroun Ambassador Bridge, Ilitch Corporation, the Downtown Development Authority, U.S. Steel, et al to invest in the restoration of the University St. Augustine’s, and fund the “USA 2 + 2 Scholarship Fund” and the “University St. Augustine’s Endowment Trust” in a nominal amount of Five Hundred Million Dollars (\$500,000,000) and collectively in the amount of Eight Hundred Million Dollars (\$800,000,000) over a 12 year period consistent with derivatives modeled by APT factors.

Further, perpetually fund the “USA Scholarship 2 + 2 Fund”. As each instance referenced provides support of teachable opportunities that have the capacity to empower Michigan citizens with an education provided “USA” is given the privilege to serve as an anchor, HBCU on the basis of a legal right as granted by the U.S. Federal District Court MI; 1.9.1985, June and August 1987, and November 21, 1995.

Upheld by the U.S. Federal Court of Appeals June 1985, and 1986. Sanctioned by U.S. Presidential Executive Order 12320; September 15, 1981, Authorized by U.S. Department of Agriculture Implementation Plan; January 15, 1985, and Recognized by U.S. Congress as Law.

Trusts shall be administered pursuant to St. Augustine’s Wealth Management Financial Investment Plan under the auspices of Controller consistent with governance by St. Augustine’s Trust Advisory Council comprised of professional that include seasoned financial advisors, retired banker, legal and financial professionals.
