Re: Notice of *Ex Parte* Presentation, *Spectrum Frontiers Fourth Report and Order* (GN Docket No. 14-177); *Communications Marketplace Report* (GN Docket No. 18-231, WT Docket No. 18-203; MB Docket Nos. 17-214, 18-227; IB Docket No. 18-251)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 3,¹ Steve Sharkey and I of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), had a telephone conference call with Will Adams, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Brendan Carr, regarding the above-referenced proceedings. During the call, we discussed the draft items released in anticipation of the Commission's upcoming December Open Meeting in the listed proceedings.

Consistent with our filings in the Spectrum Frontiers proceedings,² T-Mobile urged the Commission to safeguard the future of the high-band spectrum allocations at issue in the proceeding by: 1) adopting the item as drafted and moving forward with auctioning the bands; and 2) working to ensuring that the US government as a whole is in synch with safeguarding and planning for these bands to be a key element of future mobile broadband service. In addition, we expressed support for the draft Communications Marketplace Report.
