Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on October 10, 2019, Stephen Spengler, Chief Executive Officer, Intelsat US LLC; Peter Pitsch, Executive Vice President, Advocacy & Government Relations, C-Band Alliance (“CBA”), and Gregg Elias and Jennifer Hindin of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to the CBA, met with Nicholas Degani, senior counsel to Chairman Pai, and Aaron Goldberger, advisor to Chairman Pai.

During the meeting, the participants discussed the CBA’s proposal to clear, on a nationwide basis, a portion of the C-band for terrestrial 5G use via a market-based mechanism. The CBA parties also discussed the need to maintain sufficient spectrum for the provision of satellite services—a point of grave concern to C-band customers. In addition, the CBA parties discussed how the CBA, as Transition Facilitator, would cover all reasonable transition costs of the affected satellite and earth station parties, and would allow all eligible satellite operators to participate in the CBA on a non-discriminatory basis. The meeting participants also discussed timing and next steps in this proceeding.
