Dear Mr. Fields:

This is in response to the petition for rule making which you filed on behalf of Y95 Radio, licensee of Station KCKY(FM), Channel 237A, Camden, Arkansas. Y95 requests the substitution of Channel 237C1 for Channel 237A at Camden, the reallocation of Channel 237C1 to East Camden, Arkansas, and modification of the license for Station KCKY(FM) to specify the new channel and community. To accommodate the modification request at East Camden, Y95 also requests the substitution of Channel 282A for vacant Channel 238A at Stamps, Arkansas, as well as the substitution of Channel 239A for Channel 237A at Minden, Louisiana, and modification of the license of Station KASO-FM, Channel 237A, Minden, accordingly.

As you are aware, the East Camden proposal is mutually exclusive with Channel 237A at Murfreesboro, Arkansas. There is a proposal to modify the license for Station KMTB(FM), Channel 237A, Murfreesboro, to specify operation on Channel 271C3 in MM Docket No. 89-290. However, our policy is to refrain from accepting petitions for rule making that are dependent upon final action in another rule making proceeding, particularly when mutually exclusive proposals are involved, as in MM Docket No. 89-290.

Therefore, we are returning your petition for rule making. In the event Station KMTB(FM) succeeds in obtaining its requested modification at Murfreesboro, you may refile the East Camden, Arkansas, request at that time.
