On October 11, 2018, at staff's request, Roy Litland, Michele Cober, and I of Verizon spoke by telephone with David Lawrence, Joel Rabinovitz, Catherine Matraves, Matthew Collins, Katherine LoPiccalo, Paul Lafontaine, Aleks Yankelevich, and Thuy Tran of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, of the Office of General Counsel, and of the Office of Strategic Planning.
