BILL OF PARTICULARS

Issues (a) and (b) of the Commission's Order to Show Cause and Hearing Designation Order, FCC 92-85, released March 26, 1992, are based upon the following information and allegations:

1. By letter dated June 25, 1990, Jimmy D. Brown notified the Commission that WKIJ(AM) was silent, and requested permission to remain silent. By letter dated July 9, 1990, the Commission granted WKIJ(AM) temporary authority to remain silent until October 9, 1990.

2. By letter dated October 8, 1990, Brown Communications ("Brown") requested an extension of authority to remain silent. By letter dated October 30, 1990, the Commission granted WKIJ(AM) temporary authority to remain silent through January 21, 1991. In addition, by letter dated December 18, 1990, the Commission granted Brown's request for special field test authorization in order to determine soil conductivity. This authorization was further extended, by letter dated May 16, 1991, through August 31, 1991.


3. By letter dated August 16, 1991, Jimmy D. Brown requested a further extension of the field test authorization. By letter dated August 29, 1991, the Commission indicated that the extension would not be granted absent an acceptable status report regarding progress. Ten days were allowed for a response. No response has been received.

4. By letter dated June 24, 1991, the Chief, Audio Services Division, Mass Media Bureau, requested Brown to submit information concerning its compliance with Commission requirements for a minimum operating schedule and discontinuance of operation, Sections 73.1740 and 73.1750 of the Commission's Rules. No response has been received by the Commission.

5. WKIJ(AM) has been silent without Commission authority since January 21, 1991. Brown has neither requested Commission permission to remain off the air nor turned in its license.
