On October 16, 2018, Hank Hultquist of AT&T Services. and the undersigned, met in separate meetings with Erin McGrath, Legal Advisor, Wireless, Public Safety and International Advisor to Commissioner Michael O'Reilly, Will Adams, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Ajit Pai, and Umair Javed, Legal Advisor, Wireless and International to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel, regarding the above-referenced proceedings. We discussed our plans to start testing CBRS equipment in our labs early next year and plan to rollout commercial CBRS technology in U.S. cities beginning in late 2019. We also discussed the draft NPRM proposing unlicensed use of the 6 GHz band and the recent proposals for sharing the band with microwave networks.
