Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules,<sup>1</sup> this letter reports on a meeting on October 15, 2019 during which John Feore, Robert McDowell, and the undersigned of Cooley LLP, on behalf of Terrier Media Buyer, Inc.; Jennifer Johnson and Matthew DelNero of Covington & Burling LLP, on behalf of Cox Enterprises, Inc.; and Dennis Corbett of Telecommunications Law Professionals PLLC, on behalf of NBI Holdings, LLC and affiliated entities ("the parties"), discussed the pending applications of Terrier Media Buyer, Inc. with Alexander Sanjenis, Media Advisor to Chairman Pai; Thomas Johnson, Jr., General Counsel, William Richardson, Deputy Associate General Counsel-Agenda Review, Jacob Lewis, Associate General Counsel, and David Konczal, Assistant General Counsel, of the Office of General Counsel; and Michelle Carey, Bureau Chief, and Sarah Whitesell, Deputy Chief, of the Media Bureau.

The parties discussed the status of the Terrier Media applications, the public interest showings contained in the applications, the markets included in the applications, and the implications, if any, of the Third Circuit's recent decision in *Prometheus Radio Project v. FCC*. The parties also urged the Commission to process and grant the applications.
