

On October 16, 2018, Elizabeth Andrion, Senior Vice President, Regulatory Affairs at Charter Communications, Inc. ("Charter") spoke by telephone with Charles Mathias, Associate Bureau Chief of the Commission's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau ("Bureau") regarding Charter's response to the general information and document request ("Request") issued to Charter on October 3, 2018, by the Bureau in the above-captioned proceeding.¹ Ms. Andrion and Mr. Mathias discussed the scope of the Request, the responsive data Charter will be able to produce, and the timing of the production.
