

After the first year from the date the station begins its program tests, Ms. Lee will be employed fulltime, a minimum of 40 hours per week, as the General Manager. As General Manager, she will be responsible for day to day supervision of all station operations including technical operations, overall format, general programming, public interest programming, sales, personnel, promotion, public relations, and accounting. She will be responsible for compliance with all pertinent local, state, and federal regulations. All station management personnel will report directly to Ms. Lee. Ms. Lee ultimately will be responsible for hiring and firing all station personnel, and for final approval on all station contracts.

Clemson Broadcasting, Inc. will claim qualitative enhancement credit for Ms. Lee's past and continuing local residence in Clemson, South Carolina, since June of 1967, for her longtime civic involvement in community affairs, and for her female status.
