



DISCUSSION

1) PURPOSE OF APPLICATION

This Technical Exhibit has been prepared on behalf of Nadine P. Richardson d/b/a Rocky Mount Broadcasting, applicant for a new FM station on Channel 239A at Greenville, Georgia. Channel 239A was allocated to Greenville as a result of MM Docket No. 89-47 (see Report and Order, released October 9, 1990, FCC DA 90-326). As stated in the Report and Order, a filing window opening on November 26, 1990 and closing on December 26, 1990 was specified. Thus, this application is timely filed.

2) PROPOSED SITE

The proposed antenna site is located on the south side of Georgia Highway 109, 2.8 kilometers northwest of Odessdale, in Meriwether County, Georgia. The attached Exhibit TE-4 shows the proposed antenna site on a full-scale portion of a USGS 7.5-minute series topographic quadrangle map (Odessdale, Georgia).

3) ALLOCATION CONSIDERATIONS

A Separation Study showing the distances to the pertinent co-channel and adjacent channel stations, outstanding construction permits, pending applications, vacant allotments and pending rule making proposals is attached. Distances were computed in accordance with Section 73.208 of the FCC Rules, utilizing the *SEARCHFM* computerized separation study program and the current FCC/NTIS database.

Although the petition which resulted in the Greenville allotment was filed prior to October 2, 1989, the site specified herein meets the minimum distance separation requirements of Section 73.207(b)(1) of the Commission's Rules, for operation as a 6 kw Class A facility. The only short-spacing noted in the Separation Study is that of the vacant allocation for which this application is filed. A copy of the Separation Study is attached hereto as Exhibit TE-6.

4) FACILITIES PROPOSED

The applicant proposes to operate with an effective radiated power of 6.00 kw, circularly polarized, at a height above average terrain of 100 meters. A 95 meter guyed tower will be constructed at the proposed site. A 6-bay FM antenna will be side-mounted near the top of the tower. The center of radiation will be 348 meters above mean sea level, 86 meters above ground.

5) TOPOGRAPHIC DATA

The average elevation data between 3 to 16 kilometers for each radial was computer generated in accordance with Section 73.312(d) of the FCC Rules and Regulations, using the National Geophysical Data Center (NGDC) linearly interpolated 30-second database. The site elevation was derived from a USGS 7.5-minute topographic map, converted to metric and rounded to the nearest meter.

6) CONTOUR DATA

The distances to the 3.16 mV/m (70 dBu) and the 1 mV/m (60 dBu) contours were computer generated in accordance with Section 73.333, Figure 1, of the FCC Rules and Regulations. The contours are depicted on Exhibit TE-5.

7) AREA AND POPULATION DATA

The area and population within the 1.0 mV/m (60 dBu) contour was calculated using the Dataworld "Popcount" program. The population figures are based on 1986 revised population estimates released by the Bureau of Census.

8) PRINCIPAL COMMUNITY COVERAGE

The city of license will be totally encompassed by the 3.16 mV/m (70 dBu) contour of the proposed station. Thus, the instant proposal fully satisfies the requirements of Section 73.315(a) of the Commission's Rules.

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9) STUDIO LOCATION

The main studio of the proposed station will be located within the predicted principal community contour (3.16 mV/m), in accordance with Section 73.1125 of the Commission's Rules.

10) BLANKETING CONTOUR

Based on an effective radiated power of 6 kw, the "blanketing" contour (115 dBu) extends 0.97 kilometers from the proposed site. The applicant accepts full responsibility for the elimination of any objectionable interference that may be caused by the proposed station and agrees that full compliance with the procedures and requirements of Section 73.318(b) and (d) will be attained. Steps will be taken to satisfy complaints of "blanketing" interference, including, but not limited to, the installation of filters, traps, or other devices.

11) OTHER RADIO STATIONS

There are no FM or TV stations located within 10 kilometers of the proposed site. Therefore, the proposed station would not cause any receiver-induced interference to any authorized broadcast station.

In the event of a problem to any non-broadcast facilities or radio-receivers, the applicant will take the necessary remedial steps to resolve the intermodulation interference.

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12) ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed construction is categorically excluded from environmental processing pursuant to Section 1.1306 of the Commission's Rules, because it does not involve a site location specified in Section 1.1307(a)(1)-(5); does not specify high-intensity obstruction lighting under Section 1.1307(a)(6); and will not result in human exposure to radiation in excess of the applicable standards specified in Section 1.1307(b) of the Commission's Rules.

Additionally, the proposed construction satisfies the requirements of OST Bulletin No. 65, ("Evaluating Compliance With FCC-Specified Guidelines for Human Exposure to Radiofrequency Radiation"), October 1985, and fully complies with the radio frequency protection guidelines contained in the ANSI C95.1-1982 standard (American National Standard Safety Levels With Respect to Human Exposure to Radio Frequency Electromagnetic Fields, 300 KHz to 100 GHz) with respect to all areas accessible to workers or the general public. In addition to the protection afforded by the height of the proposed antenna above ground level, the facility will be properly marked with signs and entry to the facility will be restricted by means of locked fencing.

13) CONCLUSION

It is believed this proposal conforms to all applicable FCC Rules and Regulations, and that all technical data has been prepared in accordance with standard FCC practices.

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EXHIBIT TE-2 **FAA NOTIFICATION**

This proposal involves the construction of a new 95 meter (313 foot) tower at a location approximately 2.8 kilometers (1.7 miles) northwest of Odessadale, Georgia.


