## Petition for Rule Making Filed

A petition for rule making filed by the Utilities Telecommunications Council (UTC) on March 31, 1992 was released for public comment today and designated RM-7981. The petition proposes "to amend Parts 2, 21 and 94 of the Commission's Rules to provide for use of frequencies in the 1.71-1.85, 3.7-4.2, 5.925-6.425, and 10.7-11.7 GHz bands by private microwave systems licensed under Part 94 of the Commission's Rules. UTC further requests that the Commission defer action in its on-going rulemaking to establish a 'spectrum reserve,' pending the outcome of this separate proceeding. See Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in ET Docket No. 92-9, FCC 92-20, released February 7, 1992."

Parties desiring to file statements opposing or supporting the UTC Petition must reference RM-7981 on the cover page of their statements. Statements must be submitted by June 1, 1992. Replies to statements must be submitted by June 16, 1992.
