Union Telephone Company ("Applicant") seeks authorization pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §214(a) and Section 63.19 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19, to discontinue its international switched access tandem exchange services to the Alton and New Durham, New Hampshire market areas. The Applicant provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission's Rules:

1. Name and Address of the Carrier: Union Telephone Company, 525 Junction Road, Madison, Wisconsin 53717.
2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance: Applicant plans to discontinue the affected services on November 20, 2017.
3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected: Applicant proposes to discontinue the affected services in Alton and New Durham, New Hampshire.
4. Description of Service Affected: International switched access tandem exchange services provide the ability to originate calls from an end user's premises to a customer's premises, and to terminate calls from a customer's premises to an end user's premises

5: Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers: Applicant does not have any customers utilizing this service.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier: Applicant is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

7. Other Information: In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules, a copy of this application is being mailed concurrently with its filing to the Governor of New Hampshire, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission and the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense.
