## **NTIA Report on 1710-1850 and 2200-2290 MHz Bands (ET Docket No. 92-9)**

A March 1992 report entitled, Federal Spectrum Usage of the 1710-1850 and 2200-2290 MHz Bands, published by the Department of Commerce, National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA), was placed in the ET Docket No. 92-9 file today. The report analyzes "the Executive Branch's current and planned use of the 1710-1850 MHz and 2200-2290 MHz frequency bands considering current NTIA, congressional, international, marketplace, and technology initiatives. This report addresses regulatory aspects for both bands; summarizes the Federal Government's current and future spectrum use; identifies the Federal Government's requirements and services provided to benefit the public; and provides the estimated Federal Government's investment for both bands."

Parties desiring to file comments on the NTIA Report must reference ET Docket No. 92-9 on the cover page of their comments. Comments must be submitted by June 5, 1992. Reply comments must be submitted by July 6, 1992.
