Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 17, 2019, T-Mobile USA, Inc.^{1/} submitted a progress report in the above-referenced proceeding regarding the steps that it has taken to extend service to the Fort Peck Reservation.^{2/}

The version of the map submitted with the Progress Report did not include the transmitter locations in operation that provide the demonstrated coverage. Accordingly, I am submitting an updated map that includes the locations of the eight transmitters in operation at the time of the filing that provide coverage to the Fort Peck Reservation. The coverage shown in the attached is identical to the coverage shown in the earlier submitted version. The four transmitter locations included in the original filing are planned future locations that will provide additional and improved coverage.

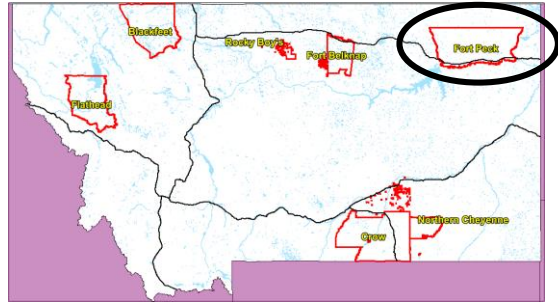
