Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. §1.1206(b)), this is to provide notice that Naji Khoury, President and Chief Executive Officer of Liberty Cablevision of Puerto Rico LLC ("LCPR"), John M. Winter, Senior Vice President, Chief Legal Officer and Secretary of Liberty Latin America Ltd., and the undersigned counsel participated in a conference call with the FCC's Hurricane Recovery Task Force on January 31, 2018. Attached is a list of the FCC participants in the conference call.

During the call, Mr. Khoury discussed the recovery effort in Puerto Rico following Hurricane Maria, including the following: (1) an update of current government and regulatory developments; (2) summary of economic conditions in Puerto Rico following Hurricanes Irma and Maria; (3) status of power restoration efforts in Puerto Rico; (4) status of LCPR's efforts to rebuild its system and to restore video, broadband, and telecommunications services to its customers; (5) review of status of online and offline customers; and (6) electric power, utility pole and other challenges affecting the recovery effort in Puerto Rico. The participants reviewed the attached PowerPoint presentation entitled "LCPR Hurricane Maria Recovery Effort," which has been redacted to remove confidential and proprietary information pursuant to Section 0.459 of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. §0.459).

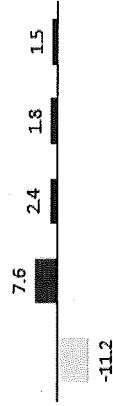

#### 1 BASELINE REAL GNP GROWTH (%)

- Real GNP will contract sharply following the hurricanes. Economic improvement is expected in the subsequent years fueled by Federal support, but GNP is severely impacted.



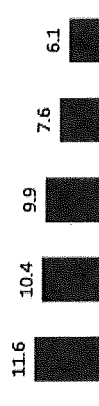
#### 2 INFLATION (%)

- Inflation increases substantially in FY18 from disaster recovery spending, but remains relatively constant in the following years.



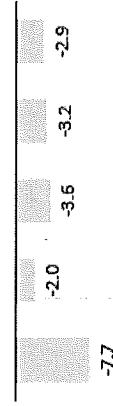
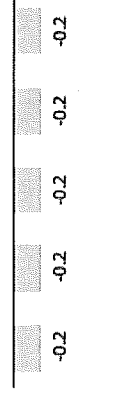
#### 3 RECOVERY SPENDING (\$mm's)

- Puerto Rico receives significant inflows of disaster relief assistance and reconstruction spending from Federal assistance and private insurers, as much as 15.2% of nominal GNP in FY19.

- Economic decline accelerates migration. Population decline accelerates following the Hurricanes in FY18 and then continues decreasing at a declining rate in the subsequent years.

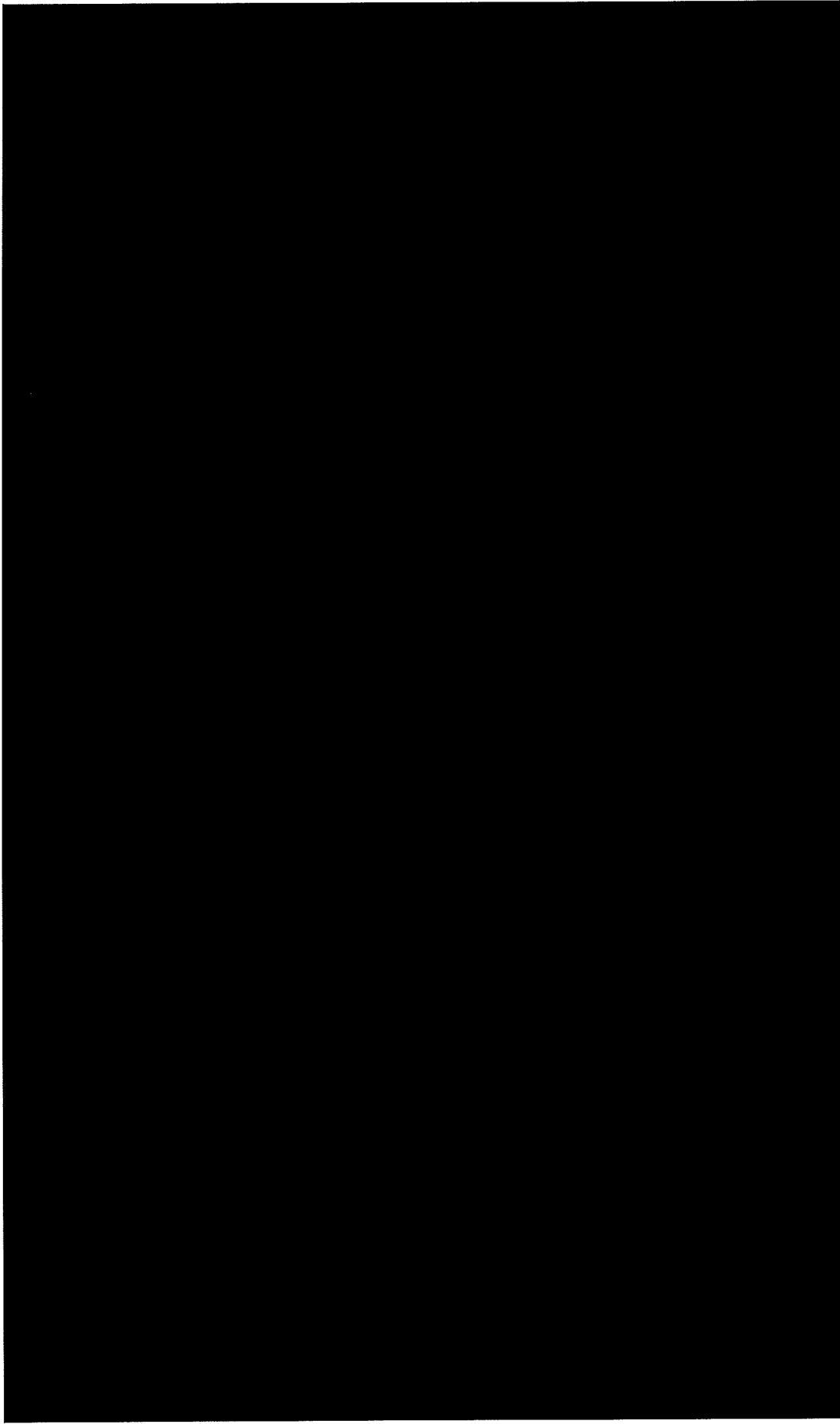

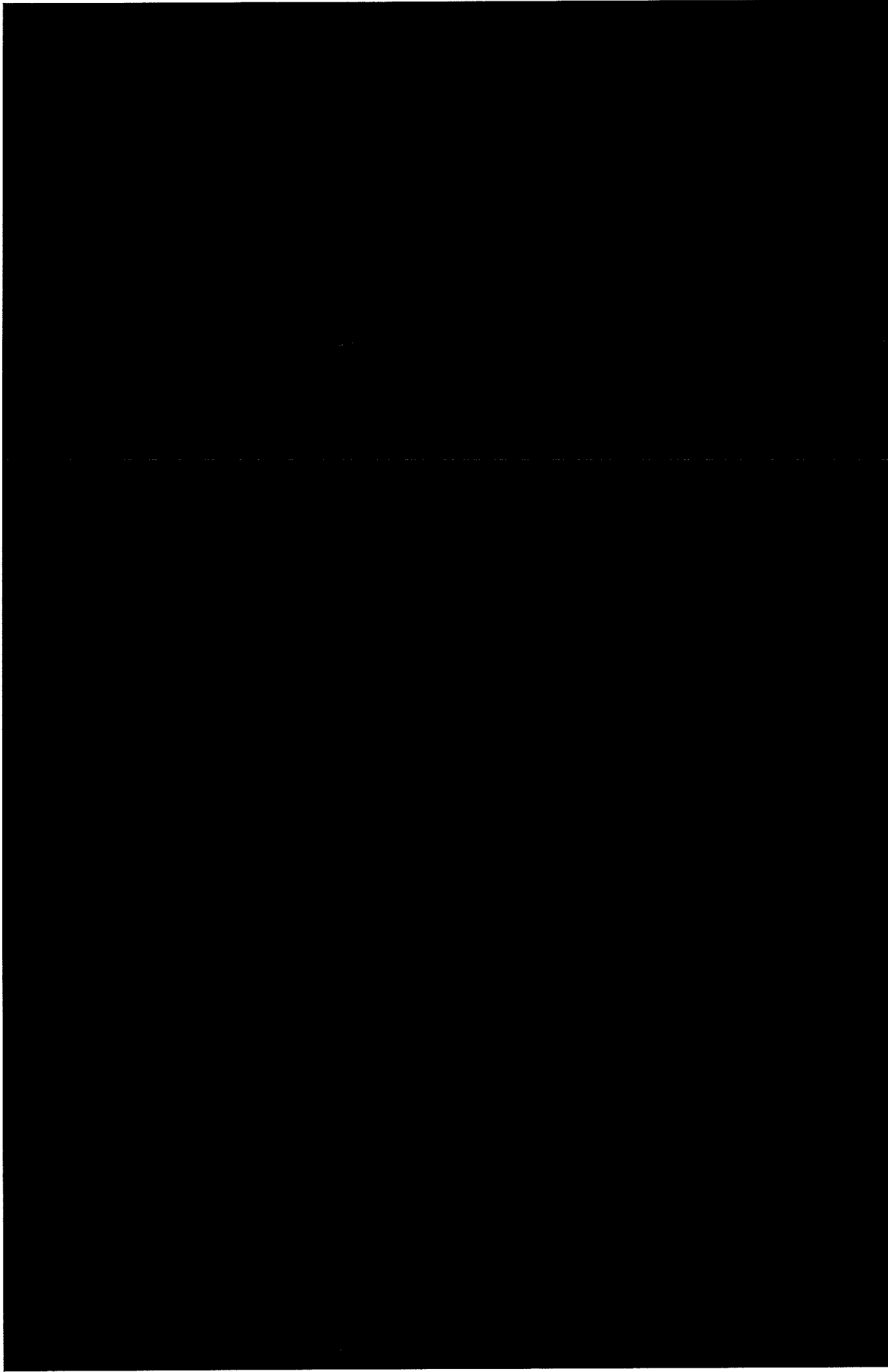

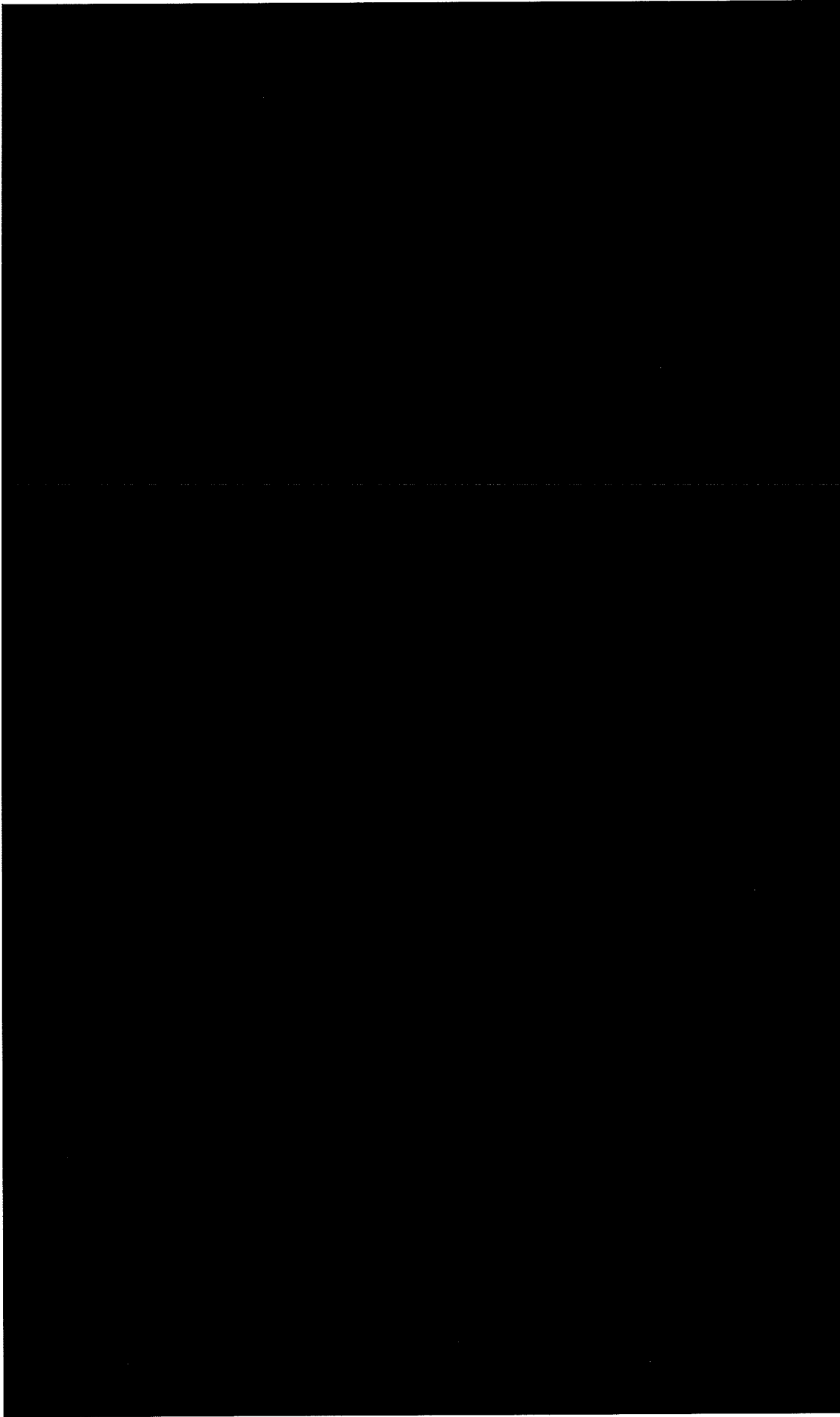


## Fiber Backbone and Hub Status



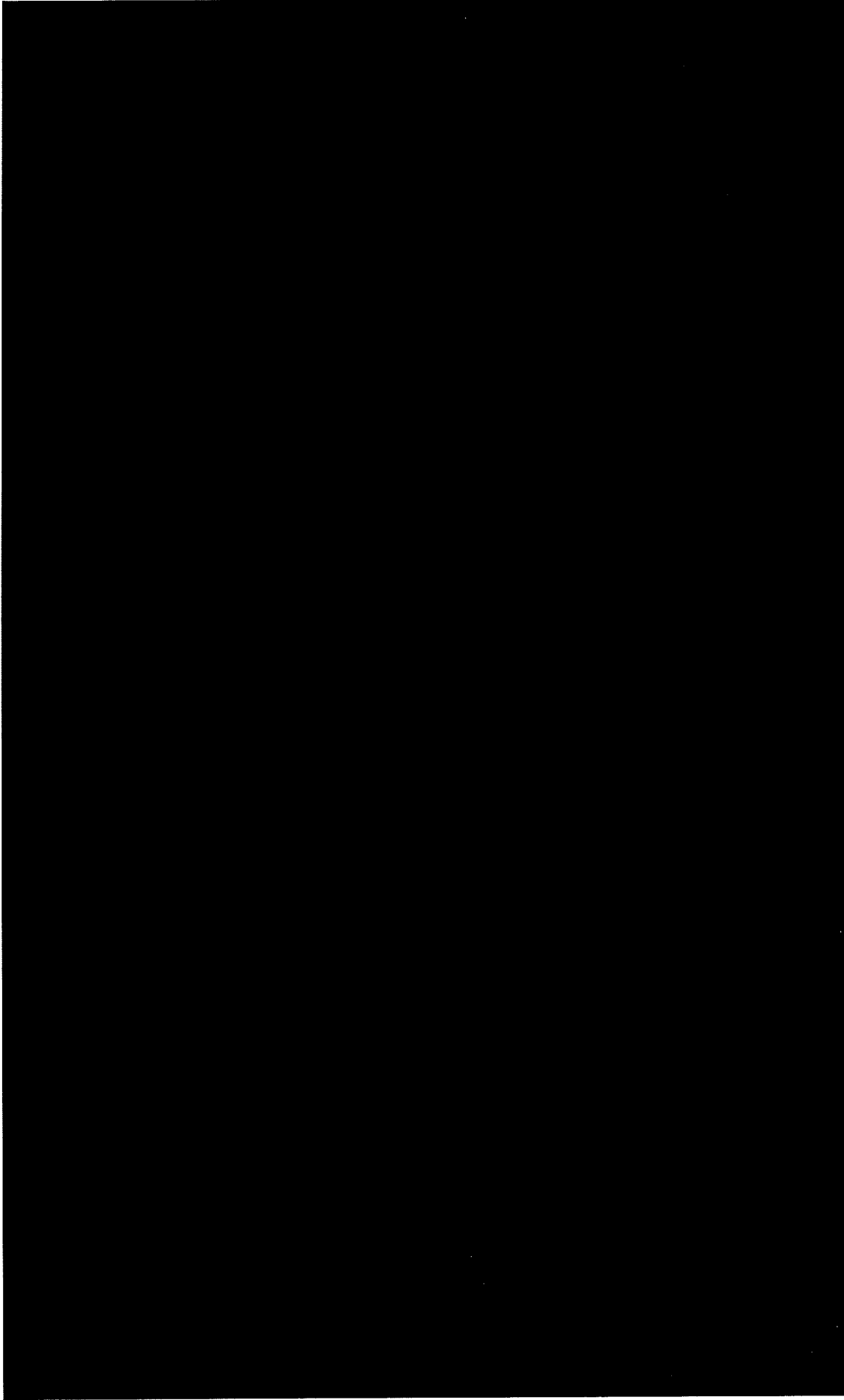
## On Line LCPR Customers by Municipalities

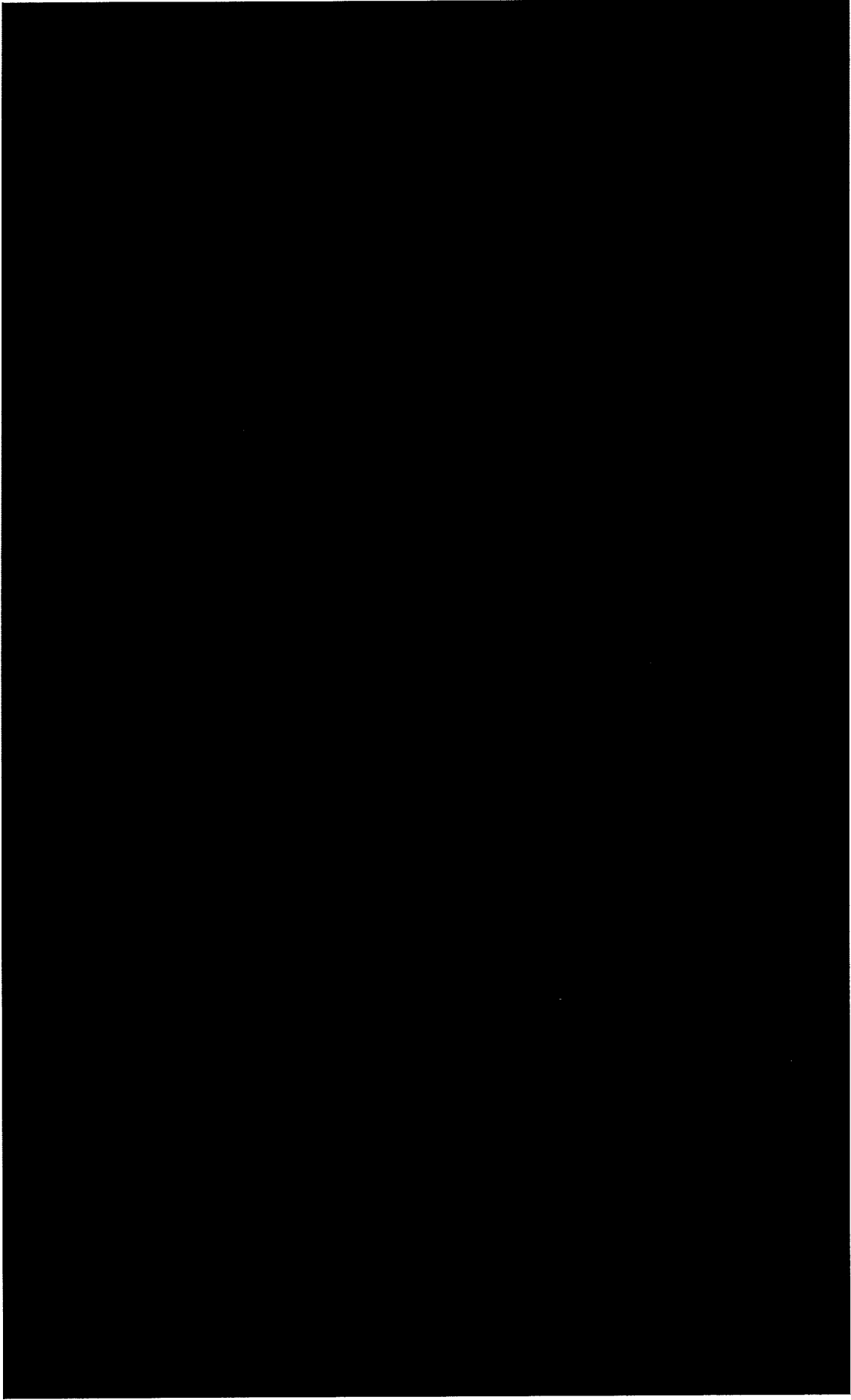


## Modem On-Line Trends since Hurricane Irma
