To Whom It May Concern

We are appealing the SLD decision to rescind funding for FRN 2790285 of 471 # 1027499

The FCDL Dated September 11, 2017 states: DRI: Our routine review of SLP has revealed certain applications where funds were used in violation of SLP rules.

We are appealing this decision as the use of this FRN was fully in compliance with all USAC rules. We had received a PQA review on this FRN to which we responded in a timely manner. Documents were originally sent in December 2016 (included).

We filed an appeal to USAC. We did not receive any follow up questions from USAC. On December 7, 2017 we received the "Administrator's Decision on Appeal" notifying us that our appeal was denied. The reason was given as follows: *During a Payment Quality Assurance (PQA) review, the applicant failed to provide the following requested documentation: documentation to prove nonprofit government subdivision status, status as school/school district, list of entities receiving products and/or services, service provider bill(s), proof of reimbursement from the service provider, proof that the applicant paid its non-discounted share of costs for products or services, technology plan approval letter (if applicable), service provider selection documentation, and documentation to prove compliance with Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA). Because the applicant did not provide the requested documentation, there is no evidence that the applicant was compliant with program rules.*

We are therefore appealing this directly to the FCC as we believe provided to USAC all necessary documentation that supports that we were fully in compliance.
