Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 6, 2019, John Donovan, CEO-AT&T Communications; Marachel Knight, SVP-Wireless & Access Engineering, Construction, and Operations; Igal Elbaz, SVP-Wireless Technology; and I met with Chairman Ajit Pai and Preston Wise, Special Counsel to Chairman Pai.

During the meeting, we discussed AT&T's ongoing 5G deployment and the importance of millimeter wave spectrum to 5G technologies. And, we reiterated that any measures to address national security threats related to the communications supply chain should be proportionate to the risk and applied to all networks and providers, not to just entities that use Universal Service Support.<sup>1</sup>
