Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Tuesday February 6, 2018, Marcelo Claure, CEO, along with Vonya McCann, Senior Vice President -- Government Affairs and Charles McKee, Vice President -- Federal Regulatory for Sprint Corporation ("Sprint") met with Commissioner Brendan Carr, and Will Adams, Wireless Legal Advisor to Commissioner Carr to discuss eliminating barriers to Sprint's 4G and 5G deployments.

Sprint addressed the barriers that face Sprint and the wireless industry in our efforts to deploy 4G and 5G services and that the Commission should quickly address the regulatory obstacles that make the densification of wireless networks so difficult. Sprint noted the significant costs and delays Sprint faces in deployment of both macro cells and small cells that are essential to providing more coverage and capacity to America's mobile broadband customers.
