Dear Ms. Dortch:

AT&T Services, Inc. on behalf of AT&T Corp (“AT&T”), files this letter to address the comment filed in the above-referenced docket by Roscha & Odne LLP (“Roscha”).

On February 9, 2017, AT&T sent a letter to Roscha via email acknowledging that Roscha requires additional time to transition its AT&T Voice DNA® for Small Business service.¹ AT&T advised that it would not terminate Roscha’s service before May 1, 2017. AT&T also reminded Roscha that it should proceed with its transition expeditiously because the platform used to provide AT&T Voice DNA® for Small Business service is no longer supported by the platform vendor. Consequently, if a service outage occurs, the service may not be restored. Roscha acknowledged AT&T’s letter on February 9, 2017 and indicated that it would update AT&T on its progress.²

As AT&T stated in the 214 Discontinuance Application, there are many alternatives in the market for interconnected VoIP service for small business customers. AT&T respectfully requests that the Commission approve its Section 63.71 Application to discontinue AT&T Voice DNA® for Small Business service.
