Kath Mullholand, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and states as follows:

1. In late October 2018, I exchanged emails with a representative of T-Mobile to obtain support for the waiver requested by Senator Jeanne Dietsch on November 27, 2018. I also exchanged relevant emails with a representative of the Commission.

As you know, part of the MF-II process was for carriers to specify particular phone sets that would be acceptable for testing. We are relying on volunteers here in New Hampshire to raise funds, purchase phones, chargers, and software as well as donate their time and mileage to test service areas.

Unfortunately, we realized a couple of weeks ago that two T-Mobile Samsung Galaxy 8 phones were purchased instead of the Samsung 8 Note or Active versions that T-Mobile specified. We've corrected the issue going forward by changing out those phones, but in the meantime we have several hours of testing that was done on the Samsung Galaxy 8 phones listed below:

We were wondering if T-Mobile would be willing to support a waiver to allow the early results of these two phones to be submitted and considered so that we don't have to send our volunteers out to repeat their testing in areas they've already covered. If you're going to submit modified data for these devices, T-Mobile has requested that you use a device_id value of 84 (the Samsung Galaxy Note 8) for the tests taken with the Galaxy S8. For the waiver request, please let me know if you need any assistance with that – I can send you an example for a waiver request submitted in this proceeding as a starting point. 
702 records will have Provider ID 65, IMEI 355982083098301 and Device ID 84 for a total of 2,335 records.
