MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Charter Communications, Inc. (“Charter”), on behalf of itself and its affiliates, hereby respectfully requests a temporary waiver of Section 12.4(c) of the Commission’s rules and a brief, two-week extension of time, until October 31, 2016, in which to file an amended 911 reliability certification for 2016.¹ Pursuant to Section 1.3 of the Commission’s rules, the Commission may waive its rules for good cause shown.² As set forth below, good cause exists to grant the requested relief.

In the process of integrating Bright House Networks, Charter, and Time Warner Cable, Charter has identified some circuits where Charter may be considered the “Covered 911 Service Provider” providing “Critical 911 Circuits” as those terms are defined in Section 12.4 of the Commission’s rules.³ For areas where Charter is certain that these two thresholds are met, Charter submitted a timely 911 reliability certification for 2016. In other areas, however, Charter needs additional time to ensure a complete and accurate certification. Charter therefore requests

a two-week extension of time to complete its 911 reliability certification for 2016. Charter submits that favorable action on this Motion for Extension of Time will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity.
